Divisions - Patterns

The categories are divided by age, gender and grade. It is possible according the bellow divisions.

D-Youth 6 - 8 Years	10 th to 9 th Kup / 8 th to 5 th Kup / 4. Kup to 1 st Kup
C-Youth 9-11 Years	10 th to 9 th Kup / 8 th to 5 th Kup / 4. Kup to 1 st Kup / Black Belt
B-Youth 12-14 Years	10 th to 9 th Kup / 8 th to 5 th Kup / 4. Kup to 1 st Kup / Black Belt
A-Junior 15-17 Years	10 th to 9 th Kup / 8 th to 5 th Kup / 4. Kup to 1 st Kup / Black Belt
Senior up 18 Years	10 th to 9 th Kup / 8 th to 5 th Kup / 4. Kup to 1 st Kup / Black Belt

Colour belts competitors choose an optional pattern from the actual belt or from the level before. In case of draw, the competitors have to perform a designated patterns randomly chosen by the electronic system.

9 th kup	Chon-Ji or Saju-jirugi or Saju-Makgi
8 th kup	Dan-Gun or Chon-Ji
7 th kup	Do-San or Dan-Gun

5 th kup	Yul-Gok or Won-Hyo
4 th kup	Joong-Gun or Yul-Gok
3 rd kup	Toi-Gye or Joong-Gun
2 nd kup	Hwa-Rang or Toi-Gye
1 st kup	Choong-Moo or Hwa-Rang

Black belts competitors perform two designated patterns, randomly chosen by the electronic system.

Level	First pattern	Second pattern
1 st dan	From Kwang-Gae to Ge-Baek	From Chon-Ji to Choong-Moo
2 nd dan	From Eui-Am to Juche	From Chon-Ji to Ge-Baek
3 rd dan	From Sam-Il to Choi-Yong	From Chon-Ji to Juche
4 th -6 th dan	From Yon-Gae to Moon-Moo	From Chon-Ji to Choi-Yong

Divisions - Sparring

In sparring, the categories are divided by age, gender, grade, weight and occasionally height. In the Sparring categories will be a maximum of 8 Kgs difference between two competitors.

D-Youth 6 - 8 Years	10 th to 9 th Kup / 8 th to 5 th Kup / 4. Kup to 1 st Kup
C-Youth 9-11 Years	10 th to 9 th Kup / 8 th to 5 th Kup / 4. Kup to 1 st Kup / Black Belt
B-Youth 12-14 Years	10 th to 9 th Kup / 8 th to 5 th Kup / 4. Kup to 1 st Kup / Black Belt
A-Junior 15-17 Years	10 th to 9 th Kup / 8 th to 5 th Kup / 4. Kup to 1 st Kup / Black Belt
Senior up 18 Years	10 th to 9 th Kup / 8 th to 5 th Kup / 4. Kup to 1 st Kup / Black Belt

Important Rules:

1. Without the presentation of a valid passport of the National Association and the Consent during the weight control, the competitor cannot participate!
2. Changes to the list of participants or categories at the tournament are not accepted.
3. If the specified weight and body size (high) is not correct, then the participant are disqualified!
4. After the closing of the weight control, participants that come late cannot participate!
5. No refund of entry fee for no participation or by disqualification!
6. Umpire requirements:
 - Up to 7 competitors: 1 Umpire required
 - 8 till 15 competitors: 2 Umpires required
 - 16 competitors or more: 3 Umpires required

Each registered club/team must bring one or more umpires according the requirements. If you don't bring the required Umpire you have to pay a penalty of CHF 75.00 for every missing Umpire.

7. ITF Dobok is mandatory
8. Only officially Recognised by ITF protectors are allowed. All competitors **must** wear the following safety equipment:
 - Gloves and boots,
 - Mouth guard,
 - Groin guard, should be worn below the Dobok. Only for D and C Youth, competitors that have not his own groin guard will be allowed to use them above the Dobok.
 - Head guard is mandatory for competitors blue belts and above, optional otherwise. In case, black, red or blue belts are mixed with competitor's blue stripe (5th Kup) and below, the highest requirement apply for everybody in the category (head guard mandatory).
9. COVID-19 Restrictions: We will apply the official requirements from the Federal council during the competition time. For the moment we have not restrictions to organize this event. We will provide you in advance more Information at the end of April.
